

Yarra Valley Uncorked Wine Tour



Enjoy a relaxing Day touring Yarra Valley's world-class wineries.

The Uncorked Winery Tour visits local, family-owned vineyards in Victoria's premier wine region.

All wineries visited use traditional techniques; hand crafting their wines to allow the regional characters to develop. These characters come from varying microclimates, influencing depth of colour, bouquet and flavour of the wines.

On this day we will visit three wineries for tastings and enjoy a lunch and cheese and wine experience.

St Hurbets – Private Tasting

The oldest vines on the property were planted in 1966 and generally yield low crops with intense fruit flavour and great depth of colour. Most winemakers in the area believe these vines produce the best Cabernet Sauvignon in the Yarra Valley.

Rochford Winery – Lunch and Cheese & Wine Experience

Rochford Winery is one of Australia's finest. Today we will enjoy tasting their range and also dine at the wineries award winning restaurant.

A little bit of latitude is what Rochford Wines is all about. Rochford is a beautiful destination. Their award winning restaurant and cellar door is surrounded by a carefully maintained vineyard, with stunning lake side and panoramic views.



Enjoy a private Cheese & Wine Experience in the Barrel Room of Rochford Winery. A selection of three cheeses will be matched with three wines, see how wines with specific cheeses complement each other, or indeed provide a contrast, to finish sample a dessert or fortified wine.

Yering Station – Private Tasting

Victoria's first vineyard, Yering Station, was originally planted in 1838. This historical wine estate was purchased by the Rathbone family in 1996, marking the beginning of a new era, with the construction of a state-of-the-art winery and award-winning wine tourism destination. As a family-owned winery, Yering Station has been recognised for its commitment to excellence, recently being inducted into the Australian Tourism Awards 'Hall of Fame' for Best Tourism Winery, 2005.
